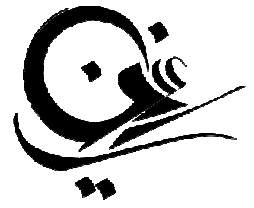

NEW WAVE OF SAUDI CONTEMPORARY ART COMES TO ISTANBUL

Edge of Arabia Istanbul: TRANSITION

Edge of Arabia, a pioneering travelling exhibition that has shed new light on the largely unknown contemporary art culture of Saudi Arabia, is coming to Istanbul this November as part of the official programme of the European Capital of Culture 2010 and under the global tour sponsorship of ALJ Community Initiatives. TRANSITION will present up to 20 Saudi artists and 80 artworks, ranging from installation, performance, photography, video and sculpture, in what is set to be the largest ever showing of Gulf artists in Turkey. The exhibition will be co-curated by Stephen Stapleton and Progress Art.

Progress Art comments, 'Saudi contemporary art has taken a big step forward in recent years, and we are very proud to co-curate Edge of Arabia in Istanbul, a Capital city of cultural importance and the symbolic borderland between East and West.'

TRANSITION features both established and previously unseen work by a new generation of Saudi artists who present their visions of a changing world. Housed in Sanat Limani (Antrepo No 5), a renowned contemporary art warehouse on the banks of the Bosphorus and directly opposite Istanbul Modern, the artists work provides a unique and unpredictable perspective on contemporary culture in Saudi Arabia, addressing both local and global issues in a dramatic flux.

Fady Jameel, President of ALJ Community Initiatives International said 'We are delighted to support Saudi Artists to participate in this timely and important project. We are especially pleased to be sponsoring this exhibition whose educational focus allows new and often young international audiences to better understand and engage with contemporary culture and heritage from Saudi Arabia, and allows new developing artists to be appreciated by the international community.'

The exhibition will be divided into four transient themes, with the addition of a guest-curated Video Art installation room. Room 1 will explore the identities of the artists within the context of their local environments and communities and includes works such as *The Choice & I Am* by Manal-Al-Dowayan and *Negative No More* by Shadia & Raja Alem. Moving on from the individual to the more overtly spiritual, Room 2 looks at the artists' subjective expression of faith and devotion, and includes artworks such as Noha Al-Sharif's *Humbly and Devout* and Ahmed Mater's *Illuminations*.

From the spiritual, we move through a connecting passage to Room 3 which examines societies move from tradition (in faith, language, urban surroundings) to modernity and man's obsession with construction, mass production and consumerism including Bassem Al-Shargi's *Jeddah Bacodes* and Sami Al-Turki's *Constructakons*. The final room presents the artists messages of hope and fear for the future, showcasing a series of dramatic works which act as both warning and aspiration, for a rejection of divisions and destruction towards a better, more peaceful and sustainable world.

The Edge of Arabia world tour is globally sponsored by ALJ Community Initiatives and undertaken in partnership with the Saudi Arabian General Investment Authority (SAGIA). TRANSITION is also partnering with and will have a booth, talks, and special art installations at Contemporary Istanbul, Turkey's leading commercial art fair, which will stimulate timely dialogue and collaboration between the Saudi and Turkish arts community.
